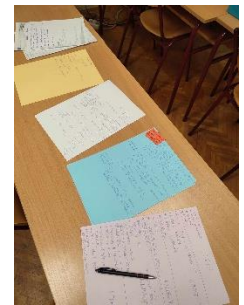

First co-creation workshop in Szeged, Miercurea Ciuc and Senta

In February, the first planned workshops were held in three locations – on the 14th in Szeged, on the 19th in Miercurea Ciuc, and on the 28th in Senta. Each meeting took place in a lively, active atmosphere, with participating partners and teachers working with dedication toward common goals. The central theme of the workshops was defining the methods and topics of training related to mobility, representing an important step in building the project further.

Teachers shared valuable experiences and practical advice with each other, which helped identify the key areas that could support colleagues' work during future mobility. After the workshop in Senta, the partners summarized the results achieved so far, ensuring that the next steps of the project would be built on a solid foundation.

Our second partner meeting in Senta

On April 25, the second international partner meeting of PedPilots was held in Senta, hosted by the Bolyai Talent Development Grammar School and Dormitory. The professional day focused on developing teaching materials to support preparation for international mobility, as well as planning the second phase of the project.

All partners of the project – the Bolyai Grammar School in Senta, the József Attila Primary School in Miercurea Ciuc, and M-

Around from Szeged – were represented. The participants worked together on finalizing the teaching materials supporting student mobility and deepened their knowledge of self-regulated learning methodologies.



Alongside the professional program, there was time for socializing: participants admired the town of Senta from the town hall tower, and the day ended with a cozy dinner and a folk dance at the local Mojo club. Thus, the meeting was memorable not only in terms of collaborative work but also for strengthening relationships between participants.



The partners will meet again in September, when the testing of the training materials will be the main focus in Miercurea Ciuc.

Second co-creation workshop

On May 15 in Miercurea Ciuc and on May 22 in Senta, the second co-creation workshops were held, followed by another one in Szeged on June 10. The participants actively brainstormed on the topic of self-regulated learning, shared their experiences, and collected further practical aspects.
