On September 27, the third partner meeting of our project took place in Miercurea Ciuc. The main focus of the discussion was the

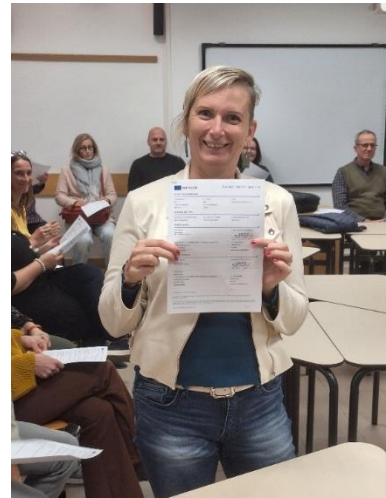


results of the training material testing: partners shared their experiences, feedback, and suggestions for further improvement.
